In today's world of work, communication is ranked as the [second most in-demand skill](#) employees need to navigate the evolving work environment.

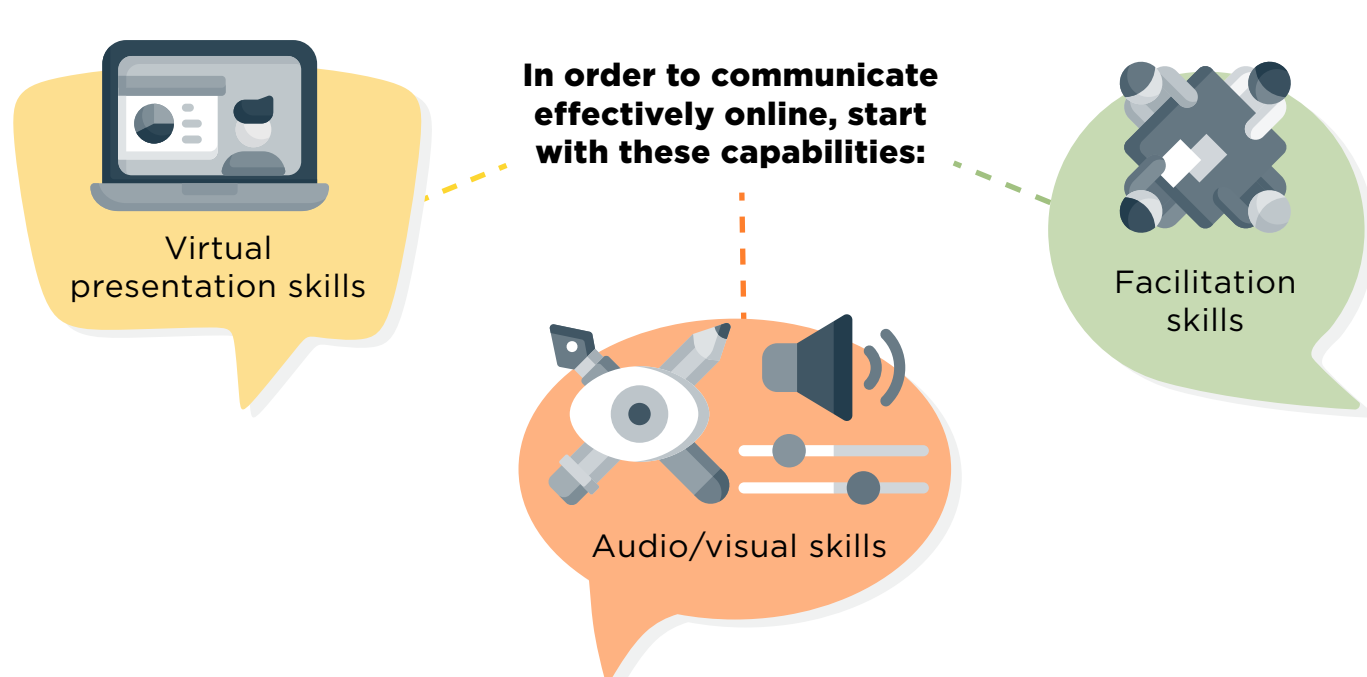


With the shift to [hybrid and remote work](#), knowing how to communicate effectively is the key to fostering employee connection.
