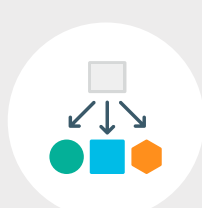

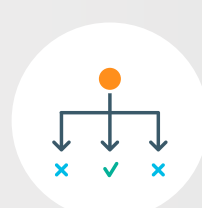
Schedule informal meetings to align on goals
